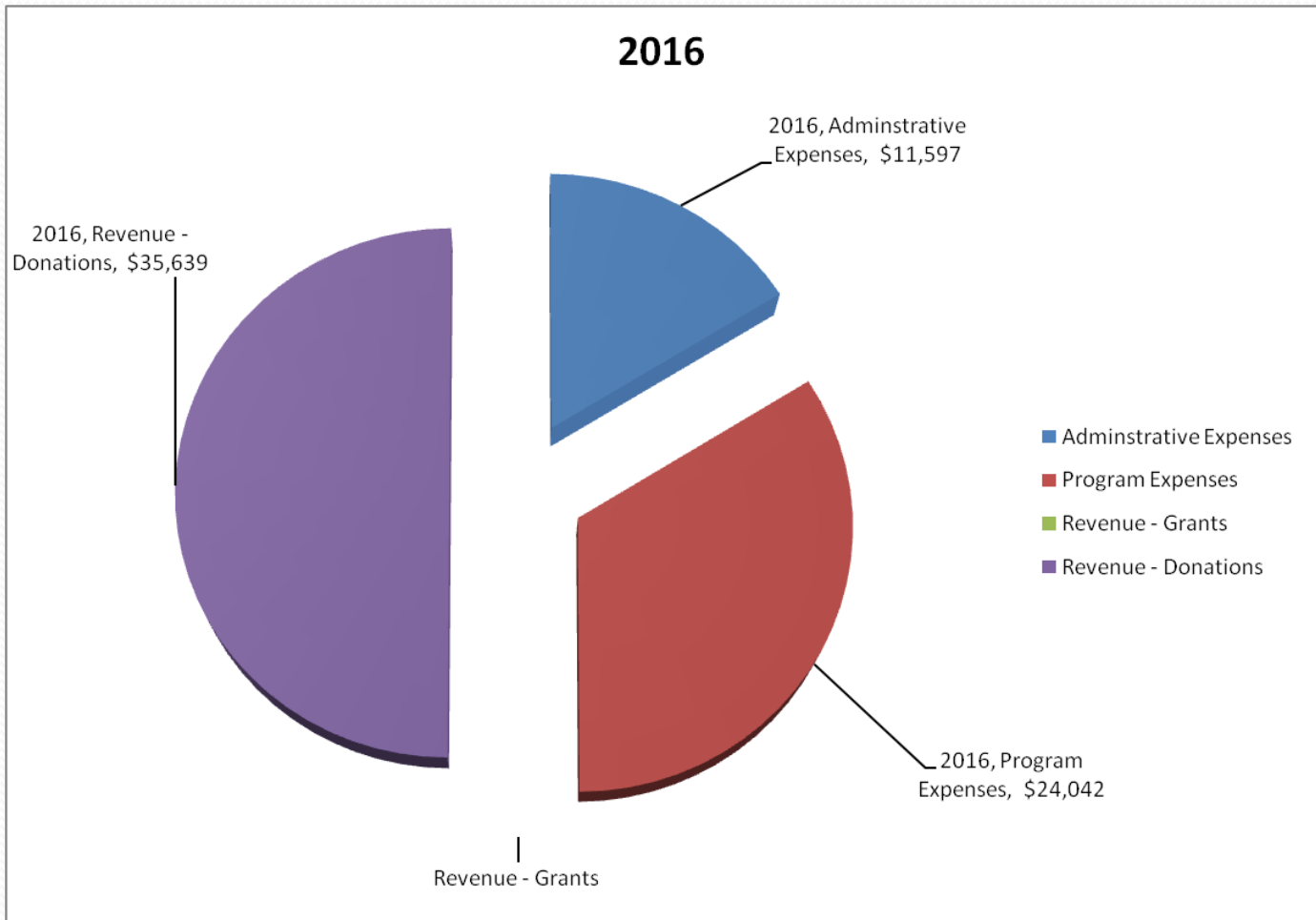

❖ **August – Back To School Empowerment Youth Rally** – youth will be provided backpacks filled with school supplies.

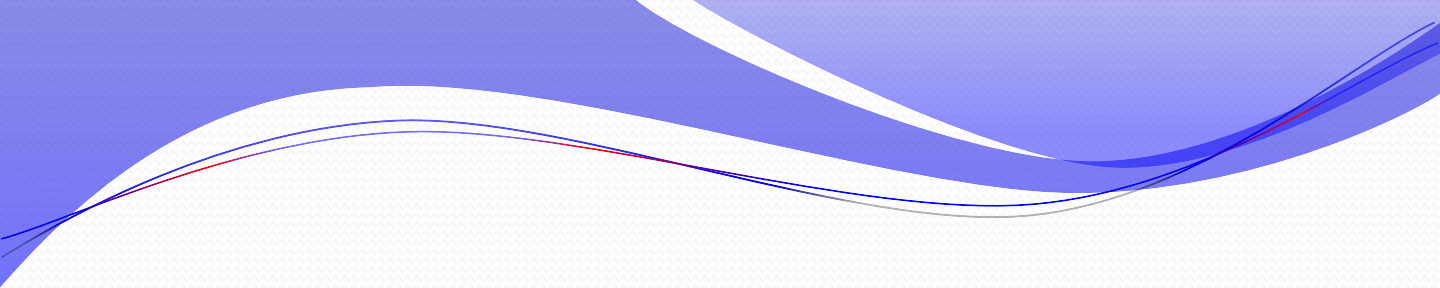
❖ **September – December – Movie Night** – monthly “Friday” night movie & popcorn for the entire family.

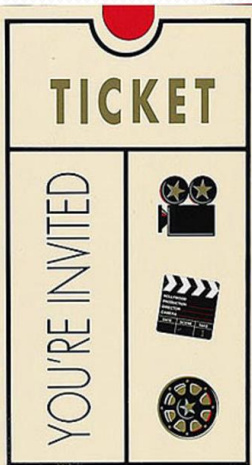

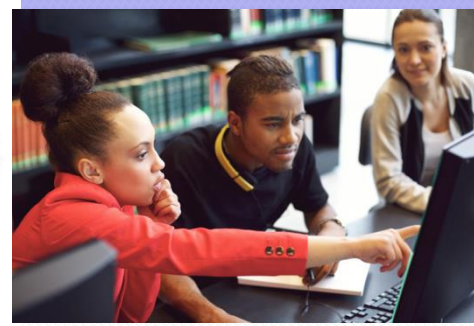
